We must not ignore their urgent pleas. And American Bible Society will not. Our tradition of delivering God's Word to America's Service Members dates back to 1817.


Through nine wars and numerous military actions since, we've ministered to our Troops with God's Word. And today our ministry is more critical than ever.


THE NEED GROWS DAILY
